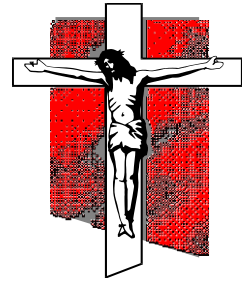

HAPPY BIRTHDAY CHRISTIAN!

Our birthday can be such fun, filled with joy! Our celebrations usually include singing, “Happy Birthday!” We also have lighted candles (not too many) on a cake, presents from friends and family and thanksgiving for another year of life (as well as delicious cake, thoughtful presents, and love surrounding us!)

Come to think of it, our baptism was joyful too if we remember it. It included clear holy water on our head (or immersion), lighted candles (the light of Christ), a new white garment (being cleansed from sin), anointing with holy oils (being covered by the Holy Spirit), and promises by our godparents. Most importantly, the priest or minister said, “I baptize you in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit!” Our souls were dedicated to God. What greater gift could we receive from the One who loves all of us!

Guess what! Pentecost (meaning “fiftieth day”) came upon Mary and the disciples ten days after Jesus ascended into Heaven. It was the birthday of the church that Jesus established! *Acts of the Apostles* by St. Luke tells of a strong, driving wind (the Holy Spirit) filling the upper room where they had been praying after Jesus’ Ascension. (We Catholics call those days of prayer the first Novena.) Tongues of fire appeared above mother Mary and the 120 disciples with her. The gift of languages was given to them, enabling them to speak to all nations and peoples and reversing the Tower of Babel!

But what did Mary and the disciples discuss between Jesus’ Ascension into Heaven and Pentecost? Deacon Jerry in our bible study said there was not yet a New Testament written. It was all oral. These early Christians had excellent memories of Jewish scripture and God’s actions in history. (Their minds and memories weren’t cluttered by the internet and social media!)

Personally, I believe they shared stories of their personal encounters with Jesus! Mary told of Jesus’ birth and early life and of her miraculous marriage to Joseph. The apostles and disciples talked about Jesus’ miracles and their three years with our Saviour. They were all humans completely overwhelmed by what God was doing. They didn’t have as Jesus did the Mind of God! Why did we need the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit came to teach us all that Jesus said and did. The Holy Spirit and Jesus are mysterious aspects of the same one true God, Our Father. As we celebrate the birth of our Christian Church at Pentecost, let’s follow Jesus’ prayer that we all become one. After all, we have much more in common than we realize!

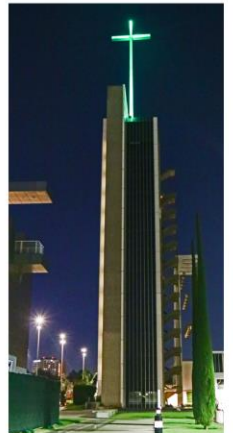
