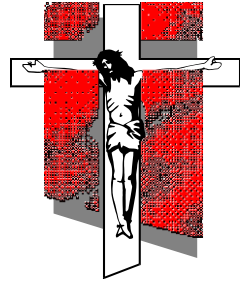

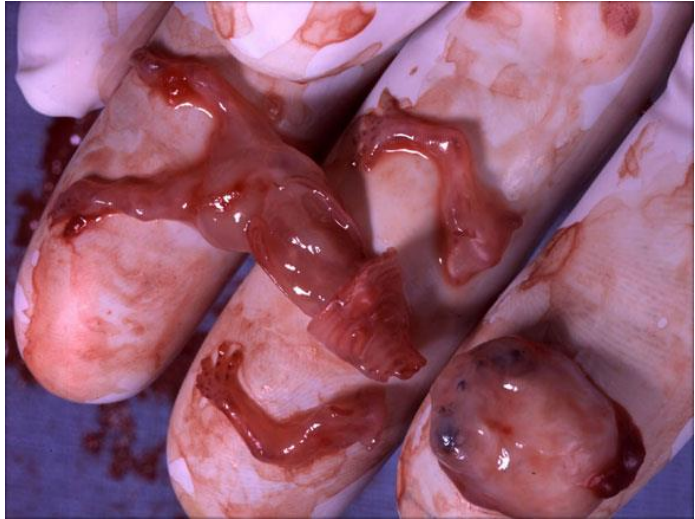

### GO TO JOSEPH

St. Joseph, husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary and foster father of Jesus Christ, has always been special in my life. I was born six months after the death of my paternal grandfather Frank Joseph Faecke, for whom I was named.

My dad Bill always had a special place in his heart for St. Joseph. He began all his projects with a prayer that St. Joseph, carpenter and craftsman, would be with him in the job. St. Joseph had a sense of humor too. In Fort Worth, Texas years ago, Dad shot a gun into a hole in the ground under a windmill after a rain storm. What came up through the hole was more than Dad bargained for. It was a dead snake drenched in water that covered the glasses Dad was wearing. Dad claimed he just wanted to see if the windmill he had bought and was taking to New Mexico was working. He wasn't hurt, but we all got a good laugh over Dad's adventure.

Sometime later after Mom and Dad moved to Southern New Mexico, Dad and my brother Jim did odd jobs to bring in a little extra money. They were supposed to take down a tall tree near a small rental home where a lady and her child were staying. Jim suggested taking down the tree a small section at a time, which is the way I learned it while working for a tree service. Dad insisted on tying a rope on the tree and yanking it over after cutting the base. The wind came up and the tree was swaying toward the house where the family was! St. Joseph stepped in, and the tree came safely down. When Dad and Jim recovered from the trauma, they had a good laugh and a profound prayer of thanks for St. Joseph's help!

On May 1, 1976, the Feast Day of St. Joseph the Worker, my wife Julie and I were married in Falls Church, Virginia.

Julie and I attended mass at St. Peter Chanel, Hawaiian Gardens, California on March 19, 2025. It was the Solemnity of St. Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. After our adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist, Padre Jose began mass. In his homily he told us to spend time in prayer in silence this Lenten Season. He said we'd hear God's voice there.

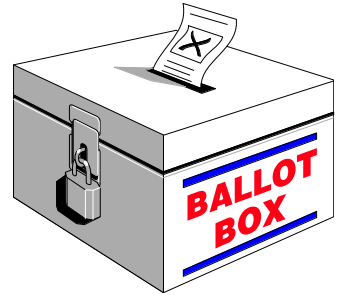
Next he told us a "powerful story." This short priest with a short greying beard said his mom in Mexico was going through a life threatening pregnancy. His dad was working in the USA, and his grandfather was in Mexico. The doctor asked Padre Jose's grandfather if he should save the mother or the baby.

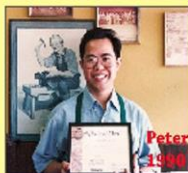
