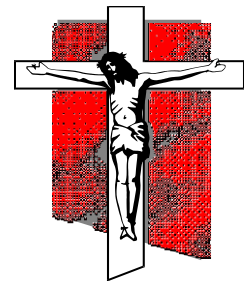

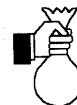

### WILD MONKEY TO PRIEST

All night long he read the story of the Blessed Virgin Mary visiting children and talking to them. The pictures and story drew him in page after page. He learned that the Blessed Mother was the beautiful woman who captures the hearts of men. She talked about God, then about Jesus. Donny read the entire book in one night!

He still had long hair and may have been taken for a “wild monkey” on the outside. Something deep inside him was changing. When his mom awoke early in the morning, Donny told her, “Mom, I want to see a Catholic priest!” She was shocked into disbelief but called a priest at 6 am. “Too early” he told her. She telephoned another priest on the base, who agreed to see Donny. He went on his own and arrived at Our Lady of Victory Naval Chapel.

The priest had his bright white Navy uniform on. Donny asked if he was a priest, and he said he was. Donny told him that he had done filthy, disgusting things. When the priest asked when his last confession was, Donny confessed that he wasn’t Catholic. It was time for mass, and the priest had to vest for it. He told Donny to “Please, sit in the back of the chapel.” In the front pew sat five Filipino ladies who were muttering the prayers of the rosary in their own language and in English. Our congregation laughed as Father Calloway imitated the women saying prayers that at the time he had no idea what they were!

A voice whispered into Donny’s ear, “Worship!” When the priest elevated the consecrated host saying, “This is my body,” a rush of the Holy Spirit struck Donny’s heart. (Father Calloway made a loud swishing noise and pointed to his heart.) He was convinced that he was witnessing the transformation of the host and wine into Jesus’ Body and Blood!

All his life Donny had longed for happiness but found it in all the wrong places. The very last place he imagined he would find it was in the chapel at holy mass! It was “God’s rehabilitation center.” (Where the cure rate was 100 %.)

Donny wanted with all his heart to become a Catholic that very moment! The priest told him it would take six to nine months to become a Catholic. Every Tuesday at 7 pm he met with the priest, who gave Donny a crucifix, the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and a picture of “Grandpa” (Pope John Paul II.) Donny threw out his old pictures, his drugs, etc.

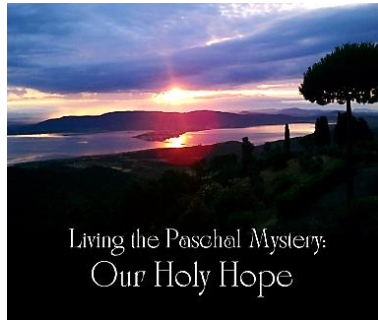
