WHERE IS MARY?

Why do Catholic Christians and Moslems have such a high regard for her? No one considered her divine! She was 100 % human. But there was something very different about her.

Christians have always venerated Jesus, Who was 100% human and 100% divine. In fact He was like us in all things but sin. A Lutheran Church sign recently read, “Sin is a short word but it has a long sentence.”

From the moment of her conception, she was without sin. God had a special plan for her. As a teenager she dedicated her virginity to God alone. When she said, “Yes” to Archangel Gabriel’s invitation, the Holy Spirit entered her to conceive Jesus. Mary was fully human and could have said, “No.” She was tempted by Satan just as Jesus was.

Throughout her life, she experienced joys and sorrows. 40 days after Jesus’ birth, she and Joseph went three miles from Bethlehem to the Temple in Jerusalem to joyfully present Him to God. Priest Simeon embraced Jesus and told Mary and Joseph that He would be the cause of the fall and rise of many in Israel and a sword to pierce her heart.

Just as the holy family was settling down, an angel appeared to Joseph in a dream and told him to take his family to Egypt. They fled that night to escape the murders ordered by evil Herod of all Jewish little ones two and under.

After journeying to Jerusalem to celebrate, Mary and Joseph travelled in separate groups a day before discovering the missing 12 year-old Jesus. They courageously returned to Jerusalem and frantically searched for Him. After three days, Mary and Joseph found Jesus in the Temple sharing His wisdom with the rabbis. He obediently returned to Nazareth and was obedient to His parents.

Years later Mary opened her heart and gave Jesus’ human side the love and strength to give Himself at Calvary as the Lamb of God. She stood by three to six hours at the Cross trusting in God and praying. 50 days after the Crucifixion, Mary completed the first novena, leading 120 disciples in prayer in the Upper Room. The Christian Church was born at Pentecost with Mary at the center and the Holy Spirit miraculously infusing the Love of God in them all.

On August 15, 2025 Catholics worldwide celebrated Mary's Assumption into Heaven. For 1,500 years until the Reformation all Christians celebrated Mary's perpetual virginity and her Assumption! Mary was filled with the Holy Spirit at her conception, at Jesus' conception, and at the Church's conception. Mary gave Jesus her unconditional love and complete discipleship more than any other human being. Is it not completely understandable that Jesus called her to be with Him in Heaven at her death? Please pray for us Holy Mary on our pilgrimage through life!

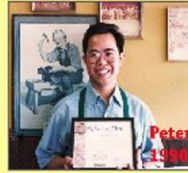

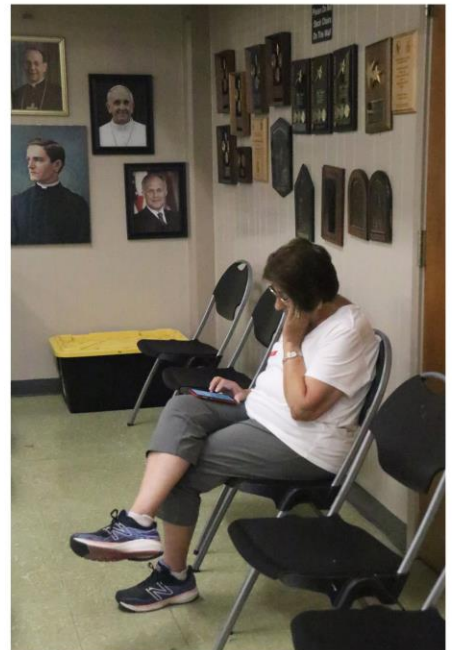
